


#### The local and regional agenda during the 7th World Urban Forum

## Call for the presentation of good practices on human rights policies at local level

The UCLG Committee on Social Inclusion, Participatory Democracy and Human Rights has been requested by the UN Human Rights Council Advisory Committee to assist in conducting a study on the role of local governments in the promotion.



### Climate change action in cities: Tokyo's carbon market policy

Four years ago, Tokyo implemented a cutting-edge policy focused primarily on emissions from 1,400 of the most energy-hungry of those office buildings. By and large, it's worked: Building owners targeted by the program have slashed power consumption and reduced their emissions by 23 percent below a baseline level.



### Intermediary Cities in the new urban agenda

Today, it would be impossible to conduct an in-depth analysis of the urban phenomenon without taking into account the role of intermediary cities, defined here as cities with less than 1 million inhabitants. In reality, these cities, at both local and regional level, account for over 50% of the global urban population.


