Analyze the positive and negative impacts that the current policies of urban renovation cause in the consolidated patrimonial urban environments, and assess, on one hand the routes the have been induced by the globalization and adopted or accepted for a great majority of public policies, worldwide, as well as the strategies that from a local level have been put into action, inside and outside of the public policies, to mitigate the harmful impacts that could arouse among the urban renovation, globalization and heritage.

1. Anyone interested must address the following e-mails:

- a. Paper title (Castilian and English).
- b. Abstract. Maximum 150 words (in the source language and in Castilian and English)
- c. Three "key" words.
- d. Indicate the position of the paper in one of the five themes of the event.
- e. Personal data of the speaker or speakers: full name, belonging institution, résumé (50 words) indicating area of interest and expertise, phone and e-mail.
- f. Word format.

The deadline for submission of abstract / resumen will be May 6 at 24:00 hrs.

- 2. Paper proposals must be sent, with a copy, to the following e-mails 4coloquiorigpac@gmail.com and alzajir@yahoo.es, a receipt confirmation will be issued by the organizers of the event, indicating the date and time of receipt of the abstract.
- 3. Proposals will be evaluated by an International Scientific Committee composed of specialists and researchers of RIGPAC. The International Scientific Committee will indicate whether the proposal is accepted or rejected on May 16, it may make necessary recommendations. Its decision will be final.



































4. In order to ensure your publication in the memories of the event, the full paper (at length) must be delivered on 24 June 2016. The author must submit with the paper a letter of authorization for the publication of his/her document, committing to make the required editorial adjustments properly and on time. Leaving deadline for such adjustments, when appropriate, on July 15, 2016.

The full paper must be sent to the email 4coloquiorigpac@gmail.com with a copy to alzajir@yahoo.es in Word and PDF format. Papers will be accepted in letter size; using Arial No. 12, justified format, numbered pages - lower end centered, line spacing 1.5, maximum 20 pages, including bibliography, tables, graphics and / or photographs (original from the author of the text or accompanied by her/his respective assignment of property rights of authors for publication) and other forms of graphic expression (provided with title and source). All photographs must be sent individually in JPG format. Template format is attached.

In addition, papers must include name of the author or authors, institutional affiliation, e-mail, document development, dating footnotes and bibliography (APA Standards). No work exceeded the amount of identified pages and without all the elements described above will be accepted. The Organizing Committee certified by e-mail the receipt of the document in a period no longer than 2 business days. Not receiving your confirmation e-mail, please do contact the event organization by e-mail.
