'Cities of Light: Paris' is a one-day symposium at the University of Paris V (Sorbonne), followed by two days of workshops in Paris. The symposium and workshops will explore the city, highlighting visual culture, social history, geography, politics and learning. In addition, urban photographic techniques, story telling and artistic practice will be presented and investigated through workshops focusing on urban life and 'light' in the built environment. The symposium and workshops will be of special interest to researchers, photographers, postgraduates, artists and all those interested in dialogue and debate around urban issues.

'Cities of Light: Paris' is organised by the Urban Photographers' Association (UPA), CUCR, Goldsmiths, University of London, the University of Paris V, University of Rennes 2 and Openvizor, with additional participation of the University of West London and the University of London Institute in Paris (ULIP).
