Program Officer

Purpose of the position: The Program Officer is a member of Oxfam under the supervision of, and in coordination with, the Indigenous Rights Program Coordinator (IP), the Program Officer supports the regional IP and Extractive Industries (EI) programs in Bolivia. The Program Officer is responsible for the implementation of Oxfam's grant portfolio in Bolivia, as well as for the program's advocacy and campaign design and strategy.

Under the supervision of the IP Program Coordinator, the Program Officer participates in the development of Oxfam's intervention policies and strategies that foster the exercise of the rights and the wellbeing of men and women from indigenous populations and their representative organizations.

The Program Officer will be a full member of the IP Program team as well as of the EI Program team, and will participate in the discussions and decisions of the Economic Justice Working Group, and -in a later stage- in the Country Leadership Team (CLT) in Bolivia.

This is a position that holds responsibility for activities in the country of Bolivia. It involves considerable interaction with other Oxfam affiliates to further common and joint programming initiatives.

- Degree in Economics, Environmental Sciences, Social Sciences, Political Science, or proven experience implementing development projects or programs, and program management and/or campaigns linked to development and social justice
- Proven experience with programs in the area of Extractive Industries, Indigenous Peoples Rights, Livelihoods, Land and Territory issues, and Climate Change
- Ample experience with advocacy work, including drafting policies and developing coalitions and alliances
- Experience and knowledge about the situation of indigenous peoples, land and territory, climate change, livelihoods, and extractive industries in the region
