This master aims to prepare graduate students for work on urban planning and other urban policy issues in both international organisations and in domestic organisations requiring expertise in international and/or European urban issues. During the year, students acquire strong conceptual, practical and methodological skills to understand and tackle the main challenges of European cities and metropolis.

Created to foster European mobility and common knowledge, the programme is defined by its courses taught entirely in English and by its strong international collaborations. In Paris, courses are offered by the Ecole d'Urbanisme de Paris in cooperation with the Ecole Nationale d'Architecture de Belleville and Marne-la-Vallée and the Department of Urban Engineering of Marne-la-Vallée University. In addition, four European partners are involved in this Master's

programme: Hafencity in Hamburg, Politecnico di Milano in Milan, Urban studies in Malmö and the Faculty of Architecture and Urban Planning in Ljubljana.

The duration of the Master is one year (full time). The master is part of the French University System and delivers an MSc degree (60 ECTS).

Admission fees: Admission fees were 256 € (+ 217 € for healthcare insurance for non-EU students) for the year 2017-2018 (French University fees).
