

## 'Day Zero' Everyday? New Report Says Urban Water Crisis Worse than Earlier Thought

From Cape Town in South Africa to Chennai in Tamil Nadu, the idea of a looming Day Zero—the day when a city officially cuts off water supplies and begins rationing water—has been at the centre of recent discussions over urban water scarcity. However, the lack of access to municipal piped water (the cheapest source of water in most cities), and irregular supply of this water has already pushed many cities to the brink, says the WRI working paper.





'Leaving no one behind' is at the heart of the commitment of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, which aims to allow all people in all countries to benefit from socio-economic development and to achieve the full realization of human rights. Caution must be taken in order to clearly differentiate between 'water rights' and the human rights to water and sanitation. Water rights, which are normally regulated under national laws, are conferred to an individual or organization through property rights or land rights, or through a negotiated agreement between the state and landowner(s). Such rights are often temporary and can potentially be withdrawn....read more
