GPPL has a strong reputation as a research and teaching hub in social justice issues related to urban studies, health studies and community studies. Combined with our commitment to decolonizing our curriculum, GPPL is ideally positioned to contribute to the expansion of Indigenous studies and the BAH Indigenous major through this position in Indigenous geographies, focusing on urban Indigeneity and/or Indigenous community health.
