**CALL FOR ABSTRACTS** 

The RESURBE III conference is principally **welcoming contributions on real cases and best practices** on urban resilience and resilience transition worldwide; able to clearly define the potential for replication and upscaling. We invite authors to **submit their abstracts on real cases and best practices around the world within the thematic areas listed below:** 

- 1. Risk management, adaptation and resilience
- 2. Methodologies and tools for resilience and systemic eco-innovation.
- 3. Process design and strategic urban/regional planning.
- 4. Intangible heritage and appropriate technologies.
- 5. Circular economy and urban metabolism.
- 6. Participatory processes, co-design and co-evolution.
- 7. Climate change and healthy cities.

## PEER REVIEW AND PUBLICATION

We invite authors to prepare and submit abstracts by **23rd January 2016 (Extended Call!!)** via our conference website: **www.resurbe3.com**. All submitted contributions (abstracts and full articles) will be peer reviewed.

After the acceptance of the abstract, we will request the authors to submit a full article for publication, to be included in the book of proceedings. All submissions must be original and unpublished.

After the Conference, the scientific team of the Conference will select the articles to be developed for peer review and for potential publication within the volumes of the book series "Resilience Cities: Rethinking Urban Transformation" (Springer). Interested authors will be invited to join RESURBE Program working groups.

## LANGUAGE

The official Language of RESURBE is English. All abstracts, posters and articles must be submitted in English. We will consider arranging one dedicated parallel session, for oral presentations, in Spanish.

## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Use the template (www.resurbe3.com) for preparing your abstract.
- The abstract shall be limited to 300 words.
- The submission should include name, title, affiliation and contact details of all authors (fill the table data summary).
- You shall indicate one or two thematic areas, from the seven listed above.
- You shall indicate your preference for poster presentation or oral presentation.
- Submissions shall be sent by Easy Chair using the Start Registration and Submission button at the www.resurbe3.com webpage.



You can opt for:

Oral Presentation: full paper + power point slides.

Poster Presentation: full paper + A1 poster

Please note that at least one author of the accepted contribution shall register for the conference, in order to present it and have it published within the proceedings.
