The broad concept of Territorial Fragility refers to a multidimensional, tangible and intangible, notion of vulnerability. This is characterized by multiple territorial and environmental factors (like seismic and hydrogeological weakness), together with physical, economic and social dimensions that is connected to the vulnerability of social groups, inhabitants and territories.

Territorial Fragility includes also aspects related to public policies, reuse and regeneration projects of architectural and landscape cultural heritage and, more generally, actions of positive transformation of the built environment to reduce social and territorial inequalities from the national to the urban scale, with attention to suburbs
