The programme

The WINTOUR master, funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union, is the first master's degree with European academic certification in the field of wine tourism. It combines the large expertise in tourism and oenology of three universities and regions in Spain, France and Portugal. WINTOUR is structured in 120 ECTS divided into 2 years and 4 semesters. The first 3 semesters are taught each in one University (URV-Spain, UBx-France and finally UP-Portugal), and the last semester is devoted to a final internship that is developed in the associated partners' facilities.

Minimum admission requirements

- Candidates must have a completed university bachelor's degree (minimum 180 ECTS) in the fields of Social Sciences (e.g. Tourism, Economics, Business Management/Administration, Marketing); Natural and Experimental Sciences (e.g. Oenology/Viticulture, Agronomic/Agricultural Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Biotechnology, Food Technology); or Humanities (e.g. Languages, International Relations), or closely related subjects.
- Candidates must present a recent English language certificate (2017 onwards), at least a B2 level according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (official certifications from Cambridge, IELTS, TOEFL and PTE Academic are accepted).
- Moreover, personal motivation, prior work experience in the field, as well as obvious linguistic skills (preferably, in the languages of the organizing universities).

Application deadlines

WINTOUR opens 2 calls for applications for the 2020-2022 Edition (starting September 2020):

- 1st call: for EMJMD scholarships from November, 14th 2019 – February, 6th 2020.
- 2nd call: for self-funded students from March, 12th 2020 – April, 29th 2020.

Application procedure

The whole process is conducted online and involves filling up a form, pay a small application fee (30.21 EUR), and submitting the required documents.

Erasmus Mundus Scholarships

Students can follow the WINTOUR Programme with an Erasmus+ scholarship

- EMJMD action (1st call for Applications). These scholarships cover students' participation costs (including tuition fees, full insurance coverage and any other mandatory costs related to the students' participation in the course), a yearly contribution to student travel and installation costs and a monthly subsistence allowance for the entire duration of the EMJMD study programme.
