

Dear colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that a number of travel and registration grants are available to support the participants of scholars who **have been accepted to present a paper in one of the RC21 sessions** at the ISA World Congress in Yokohama, 14-19 July 2014.

Three types of grants are available:

### **1. ISA-funded Registration Grants**

These grants will cover the cost of the Congress registration fee (the early registration fees for ISA members) i.e.

Category A ISA member JPY 35,000 equivalent in € 325

Student ISA member JPY 12,000 equivalent in € 111

Category B ISA member JPY 17,000 equivalent in € 158

Student ISA member JPY 12,000 equivalent in € 111

Category C ISA member JPY 13,000 equivalent in € 121

Student ISA member JPY 12,000 equivalent in € 111

**Eligibility:** Individual ISA members in good standing (i.e. who have paid the individual membership fee at least two years before the month of the ISA conference) are eligible for registration grants.

### **2. RC21 Registration Grant**

These grants cover the cost of the Congress registration fee (early registration fees).

**Eligibility:** Individual RC21 members in good standing, who have been accepted to present a paper in an RC21 session. Scholars from A, B and C countries can apply. Priority will be given to junior, or untenured, scholars.

### **3. RC21 Travel grants**

**Eligibility:** Individual RC21 members in good standing, who have been accepted to present a paper in an RC21 session. Only scholars from B and C countries can apply (see list of countries here: [http://www.isa-sociology.org/table\\_c.htm](http://www.isa-sociology.org/table_c.htm)). Priority will be given to junior, or untenured, scholars. The grant will fund part of the travel and accommodation costs, up to an amount of €1,000-1,500.

**The DEADLINE to apply for those grants is Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> February, midnight GM**
