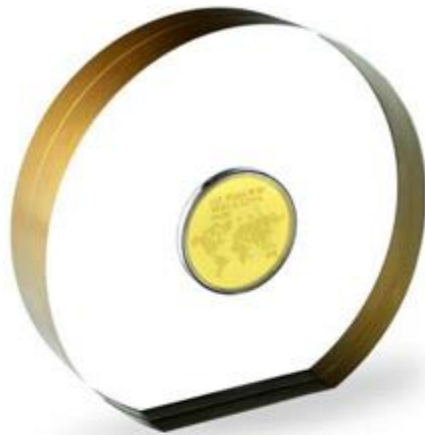


LEE KUAN YEW WORLD CITY ○ PRIZE



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS
2018

The **Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize** is a biennial international award that honours outstanding achievements and contributions to the creation of liveable, vibrant and sustainable urban communities around the world. The Stage A Nominations will be closing soon on **31 March 2017**. Submission to the Prize comprises two stages as follows:

Stage A Nomination

Nominations of cities must be initiated by **independent third parties** in *any* of the following categories:

- Leading academics (e.g. professors in universities);
- Government officials (outside of city administration);
- Head of international organisations;
- Organisations in public or private sectors;
- Non-government organisations; and
- Academic institutions.

Closing date: 31 March 2017, 6pm (+8 GMT)

Stage B Submission

Following a valid Stage A Nomination, the Prize Secretariat would inform the city to prepare and submit a detailed report for Stage B Submission.

This report shall be prepared by the city administration *after* Stage A Nomination, and using the official template available for download on the Prize website.
