While carefully crafted propaganda have enveloped these projects into a hazy neoliberal image of progress, the voices of those most affected continue to be violently silenced. Rincón Zapatista will share crucial insight and analysis from the close ties that they maintain, working in solidarity with those at the heart of the struggle.
