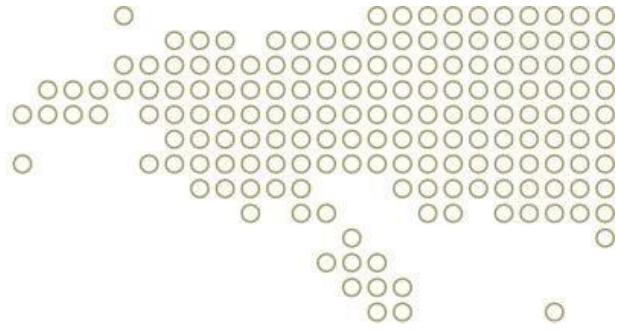
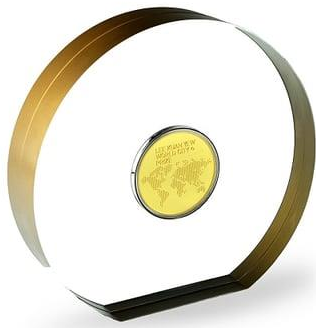


LEE KUAN YEW WORLD CITY PRIZE 2024



FINAL EXTENSION OF NOMINATIONS TO 14 JULY 2023!



The **Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize** is a biennial international award that honours outstanding achievements and contributions to the creation of liveable, vibrant and sustainable urban communities around the world.

The Prize Laureate will be presented with an award certificate, a gold medallion and a cash prize of Singapore Dollars \$300,000, sponsored by [Keppel Corporation](#).

We have simplified the Stage B submission requirements!

Stage A Nomination

Cities interested to participate should approach an independent third party to nominate them:

- Academics or institutions
- Government officials (outside of city)
- International organisations
- Public or private organisations
- Non-government organisations (NGOs)
- Industry experts

Stage B Submission (simplified!)

The nominated city will be informed to prepare and submit a report comprising the following:

- Background on city
- Overall master plan or strategy
- Three (3) demonstration projects to illustrate the success of the master plan or strategy
- *Optional supporting documents such as key statistics, city reports, videos, etc.*
