

The Indian Institute for Human Settlements (IIHS) announces the launch of the third iteration of the Urban Fellows Programme (UFP) 2018-19. The UFP is a tuition- free, nine-month, interdisciplinary fellowship and will run from August 2018 to May 2019.

India's emerging urban transition needs urban practitioners with adequate knowledge, reflective thinking, appropriate skills, new perspectives and the right values. IIHS aims to equip, nurture and prepare a new generation of graduates and young professionals to address India's complex urban challenges through the UFP. The fellowship combines classroom-based teaching, site-based applied learning, work in live projects, and external internships to introduce learners to diverse forms of urban practice.

The UFP invites applications from recent graduates and young professionals from diverse educational backgrounds with an interest in the Urban. Applicants should be born on or after 1 August 1988.

A series of webinars are being hosted till 12 April every Tuesday and Thursday between 5 pm and 6 pm. The webinars are a platform for students to interact with IIHS faculty, and a few Fellows from previous batches, who will address curriculum and subject specific queries.
