

# FAO Framework for the Urban Food Agenda

The world is experiencing unprecedented urban growth. Today, over half of the global population is urban and by 2050 an additional 2.5 billion people are expected to live in urban areas. This framework defines the Urban Food Agenda as the vast range of policies, programmes and initiatives developed and implemented by national and sub-national governments, jointly with different stakeholders from the public and private sectors, to enhance food security and nutrition and sustainable development in urban areas and in the rural areas under their influence. The process of urbanization spans diverse socio-spatial forms (mega-cities, smaller but rapidly growing cities, towns, conurbations, suburbs, rural villages and hinterlands), creating a patchwork of uneven geographies...read more
