

The [Research Centre for Tourism, Sustainability and Well-being \(CinTurs\)](#) is now inviting potential candidates for 5 Fellowships in the PhD programs associated to the Research Centre, with thesis topics that should fit to our main research fields:

Sustainable Tourism and Territories

Tourism and Hospitality Competitiveness and Governance

Tourism and Stakeholders' Well-being

These fellowships are funded by the **Portuguese National Funding Agency for Science, Research and Technology** (Fundação para a Ciência e Tecnologia -FCT) and attributed directly by CinTurs.

The fellowships include a monthly salary of 1064€, PhD fees, as well as yearly accommodation and travel for congress presentation.

The Fellowships will be ascribed to the following PhD programs:

PhD program in Tourism (Faculty of Economics): 1 fellowship. Preference will be given to topics under the research area of **Sustainable Tourism and Territories**

PhD program in Economic and Management Sciences (Faculty of Economics): 1 fellowship. Preference will be given to topics under the research area of **Tourism and Hospitality Competitiveness and Governance**

PhD program in Psychology (Faculty of Human and Social Sciences): 2 fellowships. Preference will be given to topics under the research area of **Tourism and Stakeholders' Well-being**

PhD program in Sociology (Faculty of Economics, in consortium with other Universities): 1 fellowship. Preference will be given to topics under the research area of **Tourism and Stakeholders' Well-being**

To benefit from the fellowship, the candidate must apply for any of the PhD programs for the school year 2020/2021. Classes are expected to start in September, 2020.

Candidates will be selected based on their CV and research proposal. At least one supervisor has to be an [integrated researcher at CinTurs](#) and Professor at the University of Algarve.

Potential students should send a **CV** and a maximum of **5 pages research proposal**, including references, to Dr Julieta Rosa (cintursinfo@ualg.pt) until **15 March**. CV should highlight previous research experiences, including research training and publications.
