Women are assigned the task of not being there, not finding themselves, not staying in the contemporary city's current context and its values. This attitude does not take the form of simple rejection. Instead, it finds its strength in having found words to say, articulating itself as positive, becoming the foundation in women's politics to change a society that perpetuates, by refusing to dedicate their energies only to women's maternal function. The central theme is the critical observation of the social perception of inferiority in women and our diversity's positive affirmation.

How do we see the Future from a women's perspective?

This series of meetings will see women's participation from different cultures and places that want to question particular knowledge orders known today. We will do it through a vision of the city's Future, of its public spaces and the very intimate ones of our homes, marked by a discontinuity that is the result of the "other" female gaze. We would like to understand how men can be equal through women.
