Call for paper abstract submissions was extended until May 31st, 2009

The Executive Coordination would like to inform that the submission of paper proposals was extended until may 31st. Below we send some information about the paper submission process:

To send paper proposals it is necessary to make your inscription (http://starline.dnsalias.com/isa/cadastro/inscrito/edicao_eng.asp) and, after that, access the restricted area (<http://starline.dnsalias.com/isa/default.asp>) following the instructions to send your paper proposal.

It is strongly recommended to see the approved Sessions (<http://www.centrodametropole.org.br/ISA2009/html/sessions.html>), because the proposals should be sent to a specific session, through the website. The proposals should include the title of the paper, the authors, together with their respective institutional affiliations, and a substantive abstract in English of between 250 and 500 words presenting the subject, the methods used and the main findings achieved. Each author may propose only one paper. Since the meeting is international, the official language is English and proposals written in other languages will not be accepted. The papers should also be presented in English.
