This is a second call for two PhD scholarships on urban industrial lands at Monash University (Melbourne, AU). Please share with your students. We are prepared to work around Covid travel restrictions and extend start dates for international applicants.

Applications are invited from appropriately qualified individuals (domestic or international applicants) for two Australian Research Council (ARC) funded PhD scholarships in Urban Planning and Design at Monash University in Melbourne, Australia. The PhDs will contribute to a research project called Remaking Post-industrial Plans: Urban Industrial Zoning Past and Future. This project is led by Professor Carl Grodach and Dr Elizabeth Taylor of Monash University, and Associate Professor Joe Hurley of RMIT. The project will blend interdisciplinary approaches from urban planning, geography, and history to examine the changing functions and roles of urban industrial land.

The successful applicants will receive a tax-free living allowance and Tuition Fee Scholarship. There may also be opportunities as sessional academic staff.
