

Call for nominations for the 2010 UN-HABITAT Cities Lecture Award.

The selected individual receives an Award of US10,000 and a commemorative
plaque signed by the Executive Director of UN-HABITAT.**

Eligibility criteria for the 2010 Award:

- 1. Prominent personality within the human settlements field with an international reputation and recognition;**
- 2. Significant and original contribution to human settlements research, thinking and practice;**
- 3. Development of cutting-edge, innovative and influential human settlements concepts and approaches; and**
- 4. Ability to deliver an exciting and thought-provoking lecture.**

To nominate a candidate, please submit the following documents to the HS-Net Secretariat (hs-net@unhabitat.org):

- 1. Full CV of the candidate, including a list of publications; and**
- 2. Statement of support for the candidate (not more than two pages)**

Lecture which will take place during the fifth session of the World Urban Forum to be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil from 22-26 March, 2010.
