

Calling all governments, civil society organizations and relevant stakeholders - contribute to Leilani's next report on homelessness - visual submissions welcome!

## **Deadline for Questionnaire on Homelessness EXTENDED!**

The deadline for the <u>questionnaire</u> on homelessness to inform Leilani's next report has been extended. New deadline is Friday, November 13.

Research is underway for Leilani's next report to the UN Human Rights Council in March 2016 on homelessness. Governments, National Human Rights Institutions, civil society organisations, networks, UN agencies and entities, and others with relevant information are invited to contribute to the report. Leilani is particularly interested at this time in video or visual materials that illustrate homelessness in your region.

Homelessness has emerged as a global human rights crisis even in States that are well resourced. It has, however, been largely insulated from human rights accountability and rarely addressed as a human rights violation requiring positive measures to eliminate and to prevent its recurrence.

The report will explore how homelessness is understood and manifests in diverse social, cultural, economic contexts and innovative responses to address it. Questionnaires are available in English, Spanish and French.
