one postdoc position in **urban studies**, related to a research project on the **analysis and mapping of the use and condition of (il)legality of the housing stock** in Italy, is available at the Gran Sasso Science Institute (L'Aquila, Italy; www.gssi.it) .

The postdoctoral research fellow will have to collect and analyse data provided by companies (e.g. energy supply companies) and institutions (e.g. public authorities, municipal departments etc.) on these issues. Hence, s/he must possess a good knowledge of conceptual and operational tools of analysis and representation of the territory, and must be able to use them in a critical way.

Previous experiences in the field of housing and built environment are welcomed and appreciated.

The applicant is expected to have a good knowledge of both Italian and English languages.

The research grant is for two years (annual gross salary: € 40.000,00).
