Successful applicants will be expected to engage in innovative interdisciplinary and externally funded research; enjoy teaching climatology, meteorology, and physical geography; and have strong quantitative and geospatial capabilities. With our campus located in the Baltimore Metropolitan Area and just one hour from Washington DC and two hours from Philadelphia, specialization and interest in urban climatology and related subfields are encouraged. Experience with innovative teaching and the potential to engage undergraduate and graduate students through teaching and supervision in critical and dynamic ways are highly desirable.

As the university prepares for Carnegie's R2 status, grant-funded research and readiness to collaborate with—and in—a vibrant scholarly and teaching community is further strongly encouraged.

Applications must also include: (1) a curriculum vitae, (2) a teaching statement that includes descriptions of teaching philosophy, practical approaches, and a list of potential course offerings, (3) a research statement that addresses current areas of expertise and future research agenda, and (4) a reflective statement on ways the applicant can contribute to inclusion and diversity.
