Magdalena Ferniza - The experience of the Latin American regional Group on Social Production of Habitat (GrupoPyGSH) as a HIC's good practice for exchanging, strategizing and working together.

Sociologist, advisor of civil associations and housing cooperatives, she collaborates as an expert in Social Production and Management of Habitat in the Latin American Office of the International Habitat Coalition (HIC-AL), coordinating the Latin American Group meetings on the subject and collaborating in various national and international research projects.

Nina works as a project manager at the Swiss NGO urbaMonde.
