

FACULTY POSITION

The candidate should be familiar with Spanish.

Requirements

Participants ought to meet the following requirements:

- PhD Degree (Candidates about to defend their dissertation will also be considered).
- Show commitment to excellence in independent research.
- Show commitment to excellence in teaching, as in the relation with students and colleagues (Experience in teaching is desirable although not required).
- Research and teaching areas: Leadership, Public Policy, Public Administration, Public Health and / or International Public Affairs.

Position

The School is interested in hiring one (1) or two (2) candidates in the category of Assistant or Associate Professor.

Application process

Participants must prepare the following documentation:

- Cover letter, specifying the current topics of research and the main areas of interest expected to develop at the Universidad de los Andes School of Government.
- Two letters of recommendation from researchers or academics with whom work have been done.
- Description of general teaching areas and examples of courses of interest.
- CV that includes: Publications o Presentations in conferences o Participation in research projects, including the role played on them. o Awards and distinctions o Courses taught including the institution and the level: undergraduate or graduate (course evaluations optional) o Name and contact information of two academic references (additional to the person who wrote the recommendation letter).
