I feel glad to tell you that seven years after our large interview with John Turner, our book "John F C Turner: Autoconstrucción. Por una autonomía del habitar. Escritos sobre vivienda, urbanismo, autogestión y holismo", edited by Kathrin Golda-Pongratz, José Luis Oyón and Volker Zimmermann is finally out at Pepitas de Calabaza Editors (Logroño, Spain). It translates unpublished texts by Turner into Spanish and widens the view towards his relational understanding of housing and a constant holistic reflection on place making inspired by Patrick Geddes.

The related documentary project „City Unfinished – Voices of El Ermitaño“, which portrays a self-built neighbourhood in Northern Lima through the voices of its inhabitants is taking shape and is scheduled to be launched in Lima on October 9th. The project started in 2016, when the rediscovered historic documentary film “A Roof of my Own” (UNTV, 1964) to which the British architect John F C Turner was a consultant at the time, was brought back to the place where it was once filmed. Memories were activated and the work on a new documentary started with a small Peruvian team to document what has become of this place 55 years after its foundation. The launch of the documentary film will be in Lima on October 9th at the Goethe Institute and the day after in the neighbourhood itself.

The first phase of the project and its presentation at the Habitat III Conference in Quito was supported by the British Building and Social Housing Foundation BSHF and kept going with own means. But we still need some funds for the post-production and musicalization.
